



Addendum #2 to Solid Waste Services Request for Proposal (RFP)

Subject: Clarification of Questions for Solid Waste RFP

Dear Potential Bidders,

We would like to provide additional information clarification regarding the following questions from one of the requesters for the Solid Waste Request for Services Proposal (RFP) which has been extended by an additional week. The new deadline for proposal submission is March 28, 2024, 12:00 p.m. CT.

The questions are stated below:

1. Can you provide reports for the monthly volumes for Curbside Residential Collections and Bulky Waste Roll-Off Services?
Please see the attached volume for the past year in tonnage for the bulky waste roll-off collection. We are not charged by the tonnage for poly carts. We are only charged per poly cart, and we currently have 536 poly carts in our Town.
2. Can you provide the Contract Identification Number issued by the State of Texas Ethics Commission for the filing of the requested 1295 form?
Your contract identification number will be as follows: "Solid Waste Services 2024-01."
3. The RFP documents state that no portion of these services may be subcontracted. Would the Town allow for the use of temporary labor for portions of services provided for under this proposal?
We will allow for portions of services to be subcontracted so you can use temporary labor for portions of services.
4. The issuance of Addendum #1 extending the deadline for proposal submission is March 28th at 12:00pm. Have any further Addendums been issued?

No further addendums have been issued since the extension of the deadline as listed in the first paragraph. The deadline of March 28, 2024, at 12:00 p.m. CT still stands.

5. What is the anticipated timeline for the build-out of the new residential development?

The estimated timeline for the build-out of the new residential development of 61 homes is unknown. The developers have not provided a timeline to the city officials. Currently, only five homes are being built in the area so you can anticipate adding five poly carts for the new subdivision. We can anticipate additional costs in the future when the residences are added. Currently, we pay a set amount per poly cart versus paying on tonnage. The current number of poly carts that we have is 536 so we will add five more to that number for a total of 541 for the new homes in the subdivision.

6. What time of year is the Community Clean Up event typically scheduled for?

An annual Community Clean Up occurs in the Spring each year, typically in April. This year due to scheduling conflicts, the Community Clean Up will occur on May 11, 2024.

7. Would the Town allow for alternative proposals to the requested twice per week residential collections?

The Town will not allow for alternative proposals to the requested twice per week residential collections.

8. I would like to clarify my question regarding solid waste volumes is specifically tonnage delivered to the landfill for both residential collections and roll-off containers.


Our response has not changed from the response submitted in question one.
