- 3. <u>Filling a Vacant Alderman Seat:</u> On a motion made by Donna Clarke, seconded by John Schmersey, the council approved the following process for filing the vacant alderman seat: a notice will be advertised in the Slatonite twice, the notice will be posted on the front doors of city hall, on the city hall web-site and the notice will be mailed to each resident. - 4. <u>Budget Workshop:</u> The council reviewed the proposed budget and had the following comments or made the following decisions:
 - \$75,000 will be budgeted for seal coating.
 - Murvat was asked by the council to see if the salt spreader, asphalt cutter and water pump can be purchased in this year's budget (2009-2010) since they are small items totaling only \$10,000.
 - Harold was asked to get estimates for replacing the current supports for the water & sewer lines at the dam.
